

SIXTH GRADE SUPPLY LIST 2009-2010

Each student is asked to be prepared for the school year with the following:

To be stored in the child's backpack***:

- Pencils, number 2, with erasers. Mechanical pencils are fine.
- Pens (**blue or black only**)
- Notebook paper- 1 pack, either wide or college ruled
- One **STURDY two-inch** three-ring binder to be used as a homework binder.
- **Five** STURDY folders with **holes** and **pockets**.
- SIMPLE FOUR-FUNCTION CALCULATOR
- One or two steno notepads. One if you get the thick kind, two if you get the thin.
- Two plastic folders with **pockets** and **brads**.
- One USB flash drive with at least 1 GB of space.

***** Families are asked to make certain that a child's backpack is stocked with these items EVERY day throughout the year.**

To be stored in the classroom for INDIVIDUAL student use:

- Four 2-inch three ring binders with one set of five dividers for each binder.
- A 3-subject spiral notebook for Language Arts

To be contributed by each child for community resources, and to be turned in to your child's advisory teacher during the first week of school:

- 1 bottle of white glue or 2-3 glue sticks
- Scissors
- A package of notebook paper
- A pack or so of post-it notes
- 3 white poster boards
- 3x5 index cards
- 2 boxes of tissues
- graph paper (loose-leaf)
- One highlighter
- A ruler
- 1 pack of 12 colored pencils

To be submitted to your child's advisory teacher by August 7th:
