



BECOME A NYOS CASH COW

What is a Cash Cow? NYOS relies on fundraising/financial support from parents within the NYOS community. Becoming a Cash Cow is a wonderful way to support NYOS. Your contributions help to offset the gap between state and federal funding and the school's needs.

* The annual donation to become a Cash Cow is \$250 for the 1st calf (student), \$225 for the 2nd calf, and \$200 for the 3rd calf. Donations are encouraged at the beginning of the year.

Want to become a Cash Cow but don't want to pay all at once? It doesn't take a lot to be a Cash Cow, just a little each quarter. Cash Cow donation options are: One child = \$83 per quarter; Two children = \$158 per quarter; Three children = \$225 per quarter. Contributions are paid over 3 quarters: at the end of October 2009, the end of January 2010, and the end of April 2010.
